ACCESS TO THE MONUMENT

BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Metro lines 1, 2, 6 Charles-de-Gaulle-Étoile station RER A Charles-de-Gaulle-Étoile station Bus lines 22, 30, 31, 52, 73, 92 and Balabus then enter the tunnel close to the Champs-Élysées and Grande-Armée exits.

BY CAR OR COACH

From the outside of Paris, access through Porte Maillot and avenue de la Grande-Armée or Porte Dauphine and avenue

Coach parks: avenue des Ternes, avenue de Wagram. Accessibility: drop-off for people with reduced mobility on the Place Charles-de-Gaulle, on the Grande-Armée side.

VISIT REQUIREMENTS

Maximum luggage allowance: 40 x 40 x 20 cm, no on-site storage. Wheeled luggages are prohibited.

Restricted items: weapons, animals, glass bottles, selfie sticks, tripods, motorcycle helmets, scooters, roller-blades, sharp objects, strollers (possibility to drop the stroller with access control staff). Attention: eating food within the monument is prohibited. The Arc de triomphe does not provide places to eat.

YOUR VISIT

GROUP MEETING POINT

In the tunnel by the stone benches.

TICKET OFFICE

The group leader must come to the ticket office with the mandatory booking confirmation, printed or on their phone (priority line).

A 15-minute delay is tolerated, after which access may be denied if there is a large inflow.

SECURITY CHECK

The group has priority access to the monument at the security checkpoint. The group leader must report to a staff member.

Attention: stairs with 284 steps, but lifts are available for visitors with reduced mobility by asking on-site staff (lifts up to the museum and PRM lift up to the rooftop).

Attention: no lift between the tunnel and the platform.

Recommended visit length: 45 mn
