The Hôtel de la Marine was originally the home of the Garde-Meuble de la Couronne, the forerunner to the Mobilier National, and later became the headquarters of the French Navy.

The monument has borne witness to many of the changes that have taken place in France, from the days of royalty to the present day. Visitors have the opportunity to take an immersive tour of the Intendant's lavish and fully refurbished living quarters, along with the reception rooms leading out to the loggia overlooking the Place de la Concorde. A rotating selection masterpieces of the Al

Thani Collection are displayed in the exhibition galleries of the same name at the Hôtel de la Marine.

DID YOU KNOW...?

During the French Revolution, the Crown jewels on display at the Hôtel de la Marine were stolen without the guards noticing!
