## Coming to the Monument

Access by taking the **Passage du Souvenir**, at the top of the Champs-Élysées or the Grande-Armée Avenues

**By car:** take the Porte Maillot exit and the Grande-Armée Avenue or take the Porte Dauphine exit and the Foch Avenue

**Drop-off** point accessible on the forecourt side of the Grande Armée Avenue

**By bike:** Vélib' stations on Arsène Houssaye Street, Hoche Avenue, Beaujon Street, Balzac Street, and Traktir Street

**By public transport:** M1, M2, M6, and RER A, Charles-de-Gaulle-Étoile station. Bus lines 22, 30, 31, 52, 73, 92 and Balabus



## Visitor Comfort

**Seating available** for your convenience in the visiting areas

Please bring windproof clothing for your **comfort**

Picnics are not allowed within the monument, but you will find **shops and green spaces** in the **neighborhood** for dining



Ordered by Napoleon I in 1806 in honor of the imperial armies, the Arc de Triomphe was completed during the reign of Louis-Philippe in 1836. In 1921, following the burial of the Unknown Soldier, it became a significant place of memory where the Republic gathers on November 11th and May 8th or during the National Day.

## Opening Hours

### Summer Season

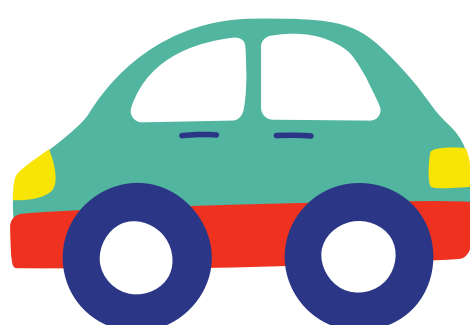
April 1st to September 30th:  
10 am to 11 pm

### Winter Season

October 1st to March 31st:  
10 am to 10:30 pm

### Annual closures

January 1st, May 1st, May 8th (morning), July 14th (morning), November 11th (morning), December 25th



## Welcome and Accessibility

**Access** to the museum and terrace: **284 steps** or **elevator** available without the need for prior reservation

**Free access** to the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier** and **free entry** to the monument for those under **26 years old** (EU)

Possibility to **leave strollers** at the monument access point

Maximum allowed **luggage size:** 40x40x20cm (no luggage storage available)

Adapted visit assistance devices in French available for **free** on **the website** and at **the ticket office** (Easy-to-Read format, enlarged characters, audio-described capsules)
